It is time for MOY (middle of the year) testing. All students in grades K – 5 will be involved in testing their progress in reading. The testing period opens on January 10th for students in Grades K – 3. These students will take the mClass DIBELS assessment. Each assessment consists of a variety of subtests.

Students in grades 3 – 5 will take the NWEA reading and math assessments. Grades 4 & 5 testing will also take a Language Arts assessment. NWEA assessments begins the week of January 22nd.
